The list is organized by state, making it easy to find gardens within a geographical area. When visiting reciprocal gardens, be sure to take your BBGS membership card with you. Also, some gardens enforce a 90-mile exclusion, which means that these gardens exclude members of other gardens that are within 90 miles of them.
