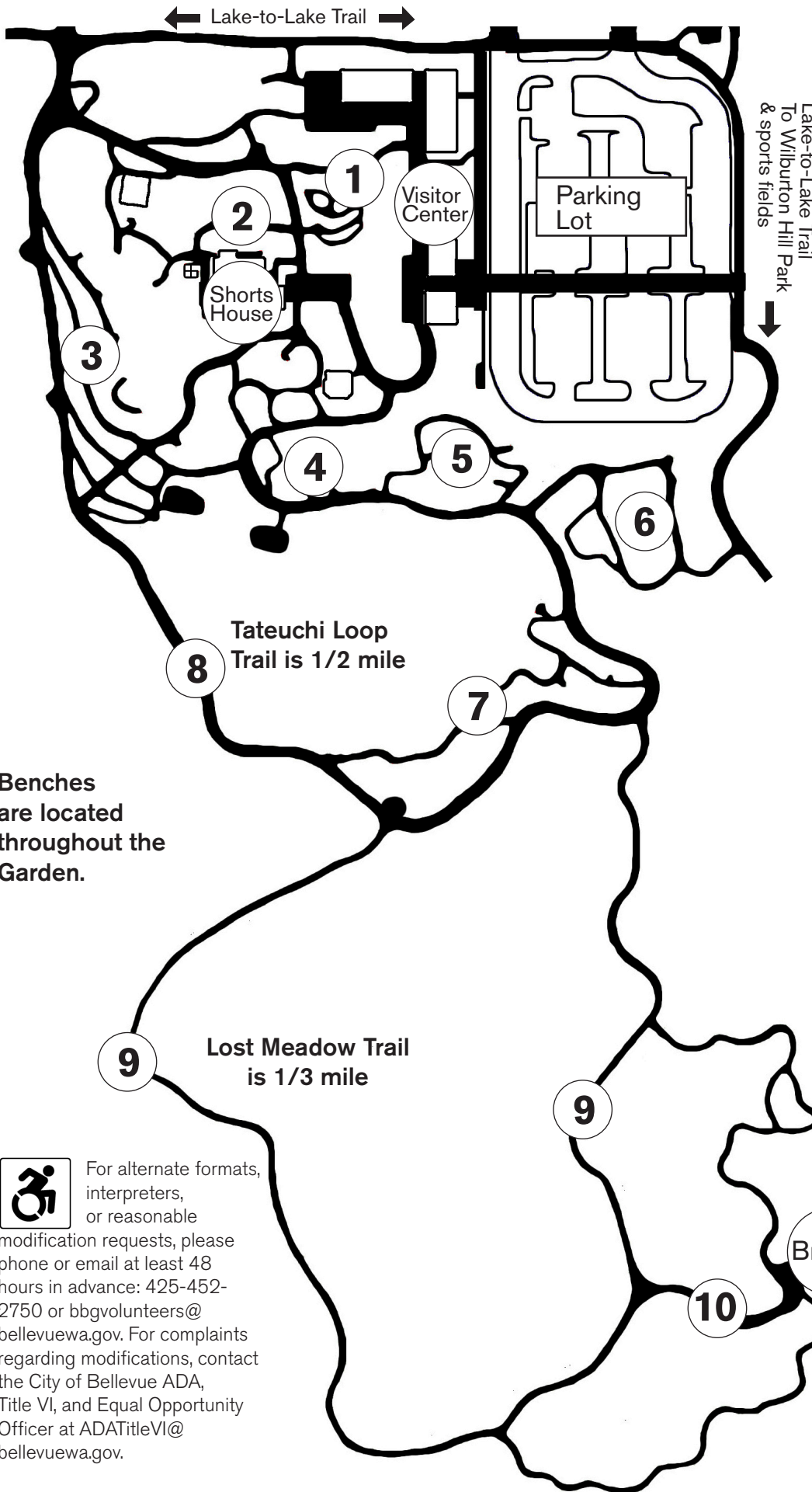


# Trails & Accessibility Guide



Parking lot, Visitor Center, Aaron Education Center, accessibility ramp, Shorts House, patios and restrooms are all paved.

**1. Rock Garden:** 1/10 mile, 4-5 ft. wide, gravel, slopes, steps, narrow paths.

**2. Waterwise Garden:** 1/10 mile, 5 ft. wide, gravel, mostly level, some narrow paths.

**3. Perennial Border:** 1/10 mile, 12 ft. wide, gravel, some slopes and mild grades.

**4. Shorts Ground Cover Garden:** 1/10 mile, 5 ft. wide, gravel, some steep slopes and narrow paths.

**5. Rhododendron Glen:** 1/10 mile, 5 ft. wide, gravel, mulch, mild slopes.

**6. Yao Garden:** 1/10 mile, 4-7 ft. wide, gravel, some narrow paths, slopes and steps.

**7. Native Discovery Garden:** 1/10 mile, 4-5 ft. wide, gravel, some narrow paths, steep slope at west end.

**8. Tateuchi Loop Trail:** 1/2 mile, 12 ft. wide, gravel, some slopes and mild grades.

**9. Lost Meadow Trail:** 1/3 mile, 12 ft. wide, gravel, slopes and some steep grades.

**10. The Ravine Experience & Bird Loop:** 1/4 mile, 4-5 ft. wide, mulch, slopes and some steep grades.

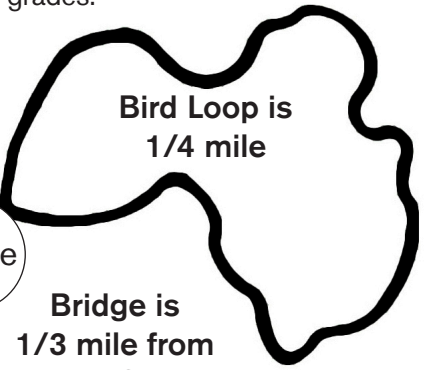
Benches are located throughout the Garden.
